



This is a club; as with any club or voluntary extracurricular activity, participation is required. Being a member of this club is preparatory for you to be a member of the National Honor Society, which is a national organization, in the Main Campus. To be a member of that organization, you have to meet certain requirements and will often need our verification that you were a participatory member of this club.

If there are any questions or concerns at any time, please see Mrs. Grossi or Mr. Lassen. National Junior Honor Society will meet every month; meeting will typically be in the cafeteria, but sometimes they may meet in a smaller setting.

Some monthly meetings will have a limited number of vacancies.

- *Students must sign up in order to attend the meeting.*
- *Sign-up sheets will be located outside of the Gym*
 - *There will be announcements indicating when sign-up begins – LISTEN CAREFULLY!!*
- *If you sign up and are unable to attend, please tell Mrs. Grossi or Mr. Lassen **PRIOR** to that day.*
 - *Failure to notify us that you are not attending and making that spot available for someone else will cause you to **not** be able to sign up early for future meetings.*

In order to be a member of the National Junior Honor Society you must:

- *Have a good academic standing*
- *A “clean” disciplinary record*
- *Attend a **MINIMUM** of **TWO** meetings this school year (not including the first and the last meeting)*
 - *while this is the MINIMUM, it is important to remember that being a MEMBER of a club means PARTICIPATING in that club, so you are encouraged to attend as many meetings as possible*
- *Participate in NJHS events such as:*
 - *the annual food drive (bring in at least one food item – be sure to put it in a bag and **label the BAG (not the item)** with your name on it so that you receive credit – October/November)*
 - *Letters of appreciation (January)*
 - *Any other “school-wide” events hosted by the club*
